

How to Set Up your Router

Thank you for using MegaTEL. If you are connecting with us for the first time or your service has changed due to moving or upgrade, this guide will provide you with all the information required to set up your router.

Your new router is already programmed so all you have to do is simply connect the device and start using your internet service.

For ADSL & VDSL

- 1** (a) Plug in the power adapter to the Power socket on the rear of the router

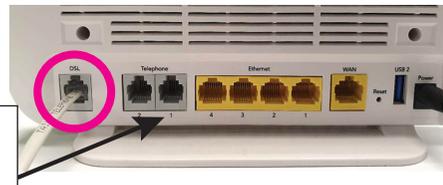
- (b) Connect the other end to a wall power plug.



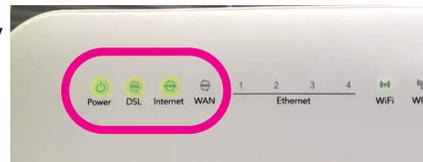
- 2** (a) Connect one end of RJ11 cable into the DSL port on your router

- (b) Connect the other end to a jackpoint.

If you opted for the internet phone (VoIP), you would need to connect the phone cable into Telephone Port 1 on the router.



- 3** If your broadband is connected correctly, you will find a solid green light on DSL and blinking green light on Internet.

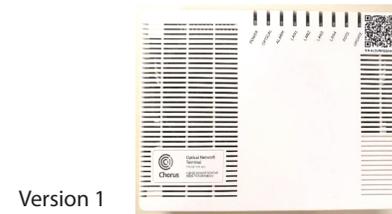

For UFB (Ultra Fast Broadband)

- 1** Locate the Chorus ONT box on a wall with Chorus logo.

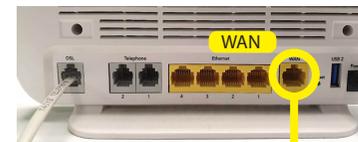

- 2** Confirm power & optical lights are on ONT



- 3** (a) Connect one end of a cable into WAN port on the router
- (b) The other end to GE1 port on the Chorus ONT box.

- 4** If you opted for the internet phone (VoIP), you would need to connect the phone cable into Telephone Port 1 on the router.



- 5** If your broadband is connected correctly, you will find a green light on WAN light.
