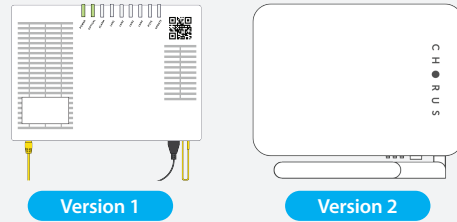


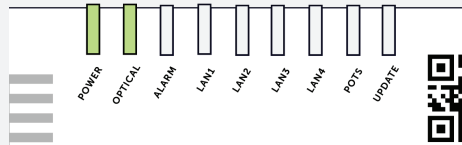
# How To Set Up Your Router

## For UFB (Ultra Fast Broadband)

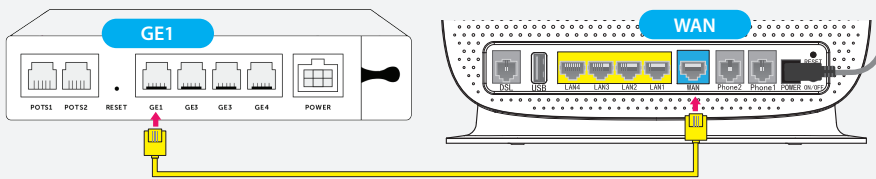
- 1 Locate the ONT box on the wall.



- 2 Confirm that ONT POWER & OPTICAL lights are on.



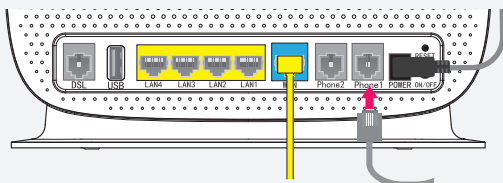
- 3 **A** Connect one end of a yellow ethernet cable into WAN port on the router.  
**B** Connect the other end to GE1/LAN1 port on the ONT box.



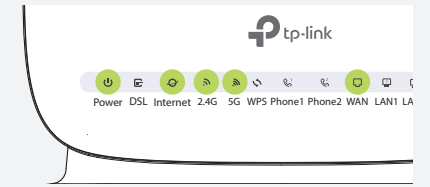
Bottom side of ONT box

- 4 If you opted for the internet phone (VoIP), you will need to connect the phone cable into Phone 1 port on the router.



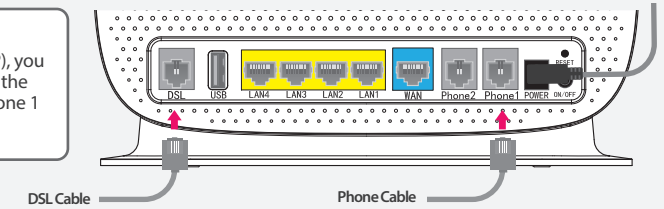
- 5 If your broadband is connected correctly, you will find a green light on WAN.



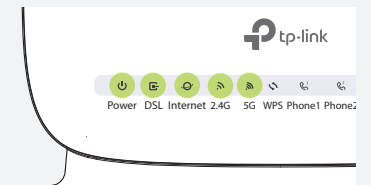
## For ADSL & VDSL

- 1 **A** Connect one end of RJ11 cable into the DSL port on your router.  
**B** Connect the other end to the phone jack on the wall.

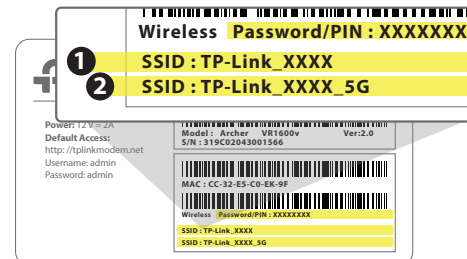
If you opted for the internet phone (VoIP), you will need to connect the phone cable into Phone 1 port on the router.



- 2 If your broadband is connected correctly, you will find a solid green light on DSL and blinking green light on Internet.



# How To Connect To WiFi



1 This SSID provides WiFi signal to a larger area with better stability. Please connect 1 to your device with the Password/PIN, if you are connecting from a location far away from your router.

2 This SSID provides faster WiFi speed to a shorter distance. Please connect 2 to your device with the Password/PIN, if you are connecting from a location closer to your router.

You will be able to find SSID & WiFi Password/PIN on the bottom of your router.

\*\* The WiFi option you select will depend on the size and setting of your home and the location where your router will be.
